Disposal of Rechargeable Batteries such as Lithium-ion Batteries



STOP!

Rechargeable batteries such as lithium-ion batteries can catch fire when subjected to strong impact.

In August 2025, a fire believed to be caused by a lithium-ion battery occurred at the Western Clean Center. To prevent such fires,

do not dispose of rechargeable batteries with regular household waste.



Products using rechargeable batteries require different sorting methods.

How to dispose of household burnable/non-burnable/oversized waste

Burnable and non-burnable waste information



1 Use a coupon to purchase Sasebo City designated garbage bags at a discount price.

About the coupon

- One coupon is good only for one pack. The number of trash bags varies with the sizes. 5 coupons/citizen will be distributed from November to December every year. There is no redistribution in the year.
- Without the coupon, the additional disposal fee of ¥840/pack will be charged.

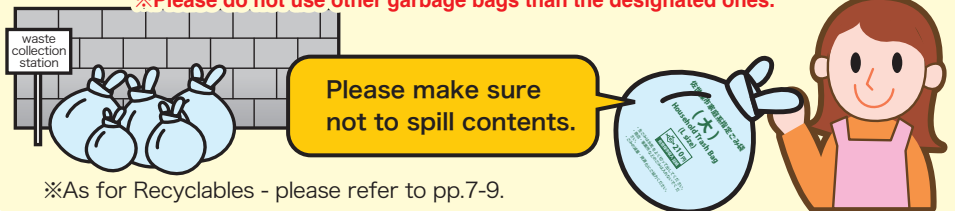

3 Put your waste in the designated bag and take it to the designated collection station. Please make sure to tie or tape up the bag shut.

About Sasebo City's designated garbage bag purchase subsidy ticket system



How do I use the designated garbage bag purchase subsidy ticket?

When buying designated garbage bags at supermarkets and convenience stores, please take out the subsidy ticket before paying at the cash register. The price will be 840 yen less than the displayed price.



Can I buy many garbage bags with one purchase coupon?

Only one set of garbage bags can be purchased with one purchase coupon.



Where can I get a purchase subsidy ticket?

Purchase subsidy coupons will be mailed from City Hall. Distribution occurs annually from late November to late December. Coupons are distributed once per year, with five coupons per person.

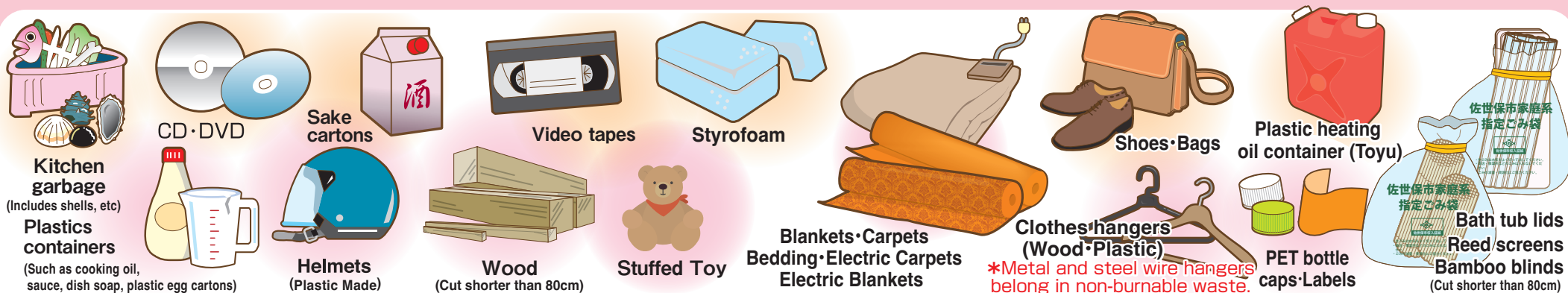

Burnable waste **Collected twice a week** Use designated garbage bags

Only items that fit into one designated garbage bag are accepted. Items that do not fit even in a large bag (45L) are considered oversize garbage. Please see page 9 for how to dispose of oversize garbage.



Designated garbage bags are not required for the following items.

Disposable diapers (for adults and children)

Put diapers in a transparent bag and write "Kamionutsu" on it by using a permanent marker pen.

Pet animals' diapers & toilet pads have to be put in the designated bag as "Burnable".

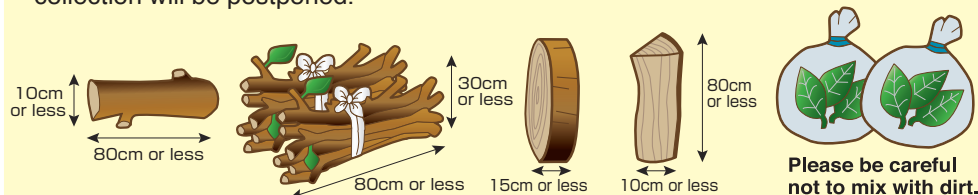


Yard waste

As for pruned wood, bamboo, and their branches, Cut them shorter than; 80cm in length, 15cm in thickness, 10cm in diameter. Bundle them no higher than 30cm. As for leaves and other gardening waste such as mown grass, put them in transparent or semi-transparent bags.

For disposal of reed screens, bamboo blinds or wooden items that you bought or made, Use designated garbage bags.

When there is a large amount of perishable garbage in the station, plant-waste collection will be postponed.



Important points on packing waste

Kitchen waste

Please drain food scraps well, soak oil on paper or cloth, put it in a plastic bag and tie the mouth tightly.



Fireworks, disposable lighters & disposable heat pack

To prevent fire accidents, please make sure to soak sparklers / firecrackers before disposal. Before you dispose of lighters, Use up or empty the gas. Cool down heat packs before disposal.



Are you throwing away recyclable items like old paper, empty boxes, and plastic bottles as "burnable garbage"? Reducing burnable waste also saves on designated garbage bags.

For disposal of Ink cartridges made by brother, Cannon, Epson or HP, use the collection box at the post office listed below.

You can dispose of ink cartridges as "Burnable", either.

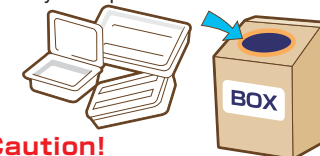

Non-Burnable waste **Collected once a month** Use designated garbage bags

Any item larger than the L-size(45ℓ) designated bag is “Oversized” waste. (See p.2)

! Please double-bag your waste with transparent bags so that you don't break the designated bag by sharp edges. You can put the following items all together in one designated bag.

To prevent accidents

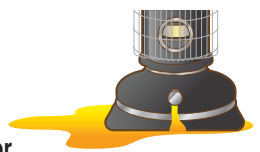
Broken or sharp items

Wrap them in paper, put them in a bag and write “ケケン” (Danger) on it, and put into the designated garbage bag.



Aerosol cans, Stoves and Fan heaters

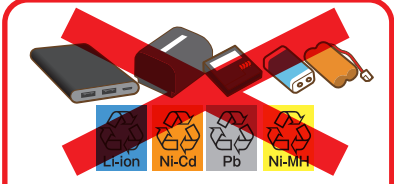
Kerosene from stoves and fan heaters should be burned off and used up. If kerosene is left in the garbage, it may cause a fire on the collection truck or disposal facility. If you cannot burn the kerosene, a small amount can be soaked up in a cloth or paper and disposed in the burnable trash. If there is a large amount of kerosene remaining, pump it out and consult a gas station for pickup. Before disposal, spray cans and cassette stove gas cylinders should always be used up, drained of their contents, and then punctured outdoors in a well-ventilated area free from fire.



Wastes no longer than 1 meter are acceptable as “Non-burnable”. Use the L-size designated bag for such waste as umbrellas or single golf clubs.



Examples of Non-burnable wastes



*Paint, oil, engine oil, etc. can be soaked into cloth or paper and be disposed of as burnable garbage. You can also dispose of the soaked items in burnable garbage. If the container it was in is made of metal dispose of it as non-burnable garbage; if the container is made of plastic, dispose of it as burnable garbage.

Recyclables

Collected twice a month

Designated garbage bags are NOT needed

Cans

- Separate aluminium cans and steel cans.
- *Please check recycle icons on cans. Please do **not crush cans**. (Crushed cans may interfere with processing.)
- *Please dispose of **oily cans, metal lids, spray cans, cassette cylinders and so on, as "Non-burnable waste."**



Bottles

- Bottles such as beer bottles, Issho (1.8liters) bottles, Western liquors, energy drinks, jams, preservable food and instant coffee bottles are recyclables.
- *Please **dispose of bottles with oil, or oil based salad dressing, as "Non-burnable waste."**
- *Metal caps are "Non-burnable waste" while plastic caps are "Burnable waste".
- *Single serving Sake bottles are "Non-burnable waste".



PET bottles

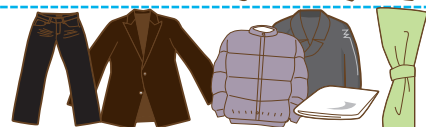
*Please do not crush them. Crushed items may interfere with the press molding process. Press molding may be hindered.

- Rinse lightly and **remove cap and label**. Bottles without the recyclable symbol, and caps and labels that have been removed **should be disposed of in Burnable Garbage**.
- Please also use the collection machines at some 7-Eleven stores in the city. (Please see page 12)
- Containers for cooking oil, sauces, detergent, egg cartons, etc. should be disposed of as Burnable Garbage



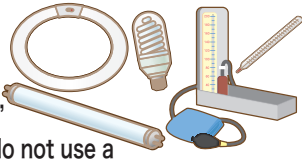
Used cloth/ clothes

- Recyclable old clothes and cloth (towels, curtains, etc.) (that can be sold at second-hand stores)
- ***Do not let materials get wet on rainy days.** Dispose of by placing in a clear plastic bag.
- *Socks, underwears, torn, dirty or wet clothing items are "Burnable waste".



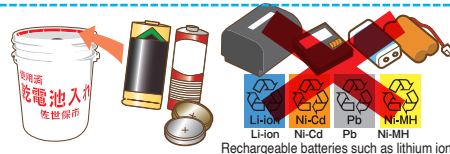
Fluorescent lamps & Mercury using meters for home use

- Fluorescent bulbs less than 40W and up to 120cm in length (including the bulb type fluorescent tube). Be careful not to break it. Wrap broken items in a piece of paper, put them in a plastic bag, and label clearly as broken glass.
- Mercury thermometers and mercury sphygmomanometers are "Recyclables". Put them in a box, so that it does not break, write "mercury thermometer" or "mercury sphygmomanometer" on the box and put it out as recyclables. If Mercury -using products break, do not use a vacuum cleaner and do not touch it directly. Make sure to wipe it off with thick paper, etc., and put it out in a plastic bag.



Dry cell Batteries

- Put used dry cell batteries and button batteries into the pail prepared for them.
- *Sasebo city will not collect rechargeable batteries. Please consult your retailer or use the collection boxes at home electronics mass retailers.



Waste papers

*Please see page 12 for details.
*Erase personal information.

- Papers with smells or stains are "Burnable waste".
- Bind the same kind of paper, tie up tight.
- **Do not let materials get wet**. Please place in a clear plastic bag.
- Place small paper scraps in a paper bag, candy boxes, tissue boxes, paper no smaller than a business card.

Newspapers, Advertising fliers



Magazines etc. (incl. miscellaneous waste papers)

Drink cartons

Remove caps, inner pour spouts which can be burned. Liquor cartons and paper cartons with silver lining are burnable garbage.



Electric appliances

*Erase personal information such as individual pics and telephone numbers.

- The following household appliances are "Recyclable", camera, portable music player, portable DVD player, video game, electric dictionary/calculator, mobile/fixed-line telephone, video camera, video deck, and radio-cassette player.



Notice for disposal recyclable items

- Separate items by type, put them into transparent and semi transparent bags for disposal.
- When disposing of cans, bottles and plastic PET bottles, empty the contents, rinse out, and do not crush.
- *Please do not dispose of cans or bottles that contains cigarette butts.
- Caps of bottles and PET bottles:
 - Metal one... "Non-burnable"**
 - Plastic one... "Burnable"**
- Oily and dirty bottles, cans and PET bottles are not recyclable items.

Information about the Disposal of the 5 Major Household Appliances

**Keep our city clean.
Illegal dumping and littering
are strictly prohibited.**



The 5 Major Household Appliances **can not be disposed of at neighborhood collection stations or Clean Centers.** Please contact the place of purchase for disposal. Otherwise, you can bring them to the designated collection locations below with a electronics recycle You can by it at any post office.

Five Major Household Appliances are required to be recycled based on the Home Appliance Recycling Law. These home appliances contain not only useful resources, but also chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs), which deplete the ozone layer and cause global warming, and lead, which is harmful to the environment. Consumers are required to pay a recycling fee, dealers are required to take them back, and appliance manufacturers are required to recycle them.

A transfer fee is also required to pay the recycling fee at the post office. Please fill in the required items such as the manufacturer code on the home appliance recycling ticket.

Disposal of motorcycles and scooters

There are four main ways to dispose of motorcycles and scooters.

- Sell to a specialized buyer
- Consult with a store that handles discarded motorcycles
- Take to a designated collection point for motorcycle recycling (Yamaguchi Shoten)
- Ask a waste collection company

Motorcycles and scooters can be repaired or refurbished, and are said to be highly reusable products that can be reused for parts if disassembled. When using the motorcycle recycling system, you must check whether it is eligible. Up to one box, including the computer, is free. The size of the box must be 140 cm in total, with three sides together, and it must weigh up to 20 kg. When requesting data erasure, if the computer itself is not included, or if a CRT display is to be collected, a fee will be charged. Please check carefully before applying.

Notes on how to dispose of garbage

How to dispose of waste paper

Please make sure to sort the various types of waste paper appropriately!



※Put it in a paper bag and tie it with string to prevent the contents from spilling out even if it falls over.
When throwing away empty cigarette packs, please remove the film and silver paper.

Paper wastes other than those on page 7 are also recyclable.
Please sort as shown above and reduce your burnable garbage.

Attention

Most paper larger than business cards are recyclable, but put the following paper out as "Burnable".

Drain and dispose of food scraps!

Vegetable peels from cooking should be placed directly into plastic bags to avoid getting them wet!

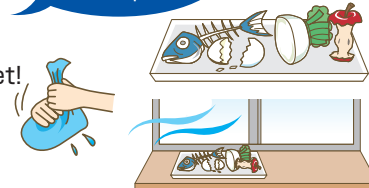
② Drain water thoroughly

If something gets wet, give it a squeeze!

③ Dry before discarding.

Placing them in a well-ventilated area will reduce both moisture and weight!

The following three points are important for food waste disposal.



Caution!

○ For safe disposal of mercury using items.

In order to avoid breakage, put them in a box.
Label the item name: "Fluorescent lamp", "Mercury Manometer" and "Mercury Thermometer", for example.
Mercury using wastes from households are "Recyclable".

○ Empty spray cans before disposal

If gas remains, spray cans may explode in the fragmentation machine.

Please vent cans before disposal, in the open air, and empty them completely.

Spray cans are "Non-burnable".

○ Sasebo city does not collect rechargeable batteries.

You cannot leave them in the collection station.

The clean centers do not accept them, either.

For disposal of rechargeable batteries, use collection boxes at mass-electric-stores or consult your retail dealer.

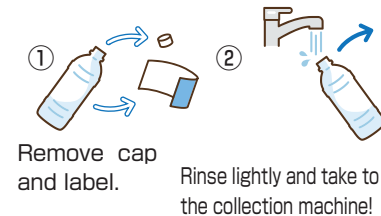


About PET Bottles Recycle plastic bottles into PET bottles!

Plastic bottles have traditionally been recycled into molded products or transformed into sheets, films, fibers, and other goods. However, recycling these products again is difficult, and most have been disposed of through incineration or similar methods.

On the other hand, the "bottle-to-bottle" recycling initiative, which recycles PET bottles back into new PET bottles, enables the semi-permanent circulation of PET bottles as a resource. This reduces the consumption of resources and contributes to lowering CO2 emissions.

Seven-Eleven has placed PET bottle recycling machines at its stores to promote its "Bottle to Bottle" initiative. Sasebo City is also collaborating on this initiative, cooperating in the effective utilization of resources and other areas.
※Please note that some stores do not have PET bottle recycling machines installed.



The procedure is the same as for disposing of them at a resource station. Removed caps and labels are Burnable Garbage. You can also earn points with your nanaco card.

Utilization of unwanted household items

If you dispose of it as "garbage", you will be charged a "fee", but if you reuse or recycle it, you may be able to sell it. If you throw it away, it's "garbage", but if someone uses it, it's a "resource". It's an initiative that is kind to both the environment and your wallet.

Rechargeable batteries are batteries that can be used repeatedly by recharging them. They are used in various devices such as smartphones and game consoles.

The main types of rechargeable batteries include lithium-ion batteries, nickel-metal hydride batteries, and nickel-cadmium batteries.

These rechargeable batteries, especially lithium-ion batteries, can catch fire due to strong impacts such as crushing or compression.

If a fire occurs in a collection vehicle or at a clean center, the facility will shut down, significantly impacting citizens' lives. Therefore, we ask for your cooperation in proper sorting.

How to Dispose of Rechargeable Batteries

Please dispose of mobile batteries, lithium-ion batteries, and similar items using one of the following methods:

- ① Ask the store where you purchased it to take it back.
 - ② If the store where you purchased the item cannot accept it, or if you do not know the store, consult a JBRC partner store (use the recycling box).
 - ③ If the item cannot be picked up at the store due to expansion, etc., please contact the Clean Center.

※If the battery can be removed, be sure to remove it.

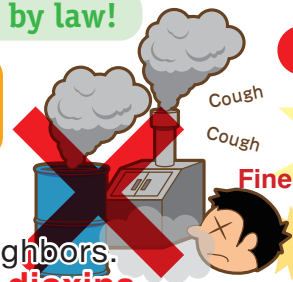
Items that are neither non-combustible waste nor recyclables

Mobile battery, Electric-assist bicycle

- For mobile batteries, consult the store where you purchased them, or use the recycling boxes at JBRC partner stores. If the store cannot accept them, please contact your local Clean Center.
- Remove the battery from your electric-assist bicycle and contact the store where you purchased it. (See page 11 for details.) The bicycle without the battery is considered bulky waste.

Outdoor burning of waste is prohibited by law!

- Unable to open the windows on nice days.
- Bad smell sticks to clothes.
- Suffering from a waste burning smoke.



Those complaints are often made.

Open burning creates a nuisance to neighbors.
Some materials can be sources of dioxins.

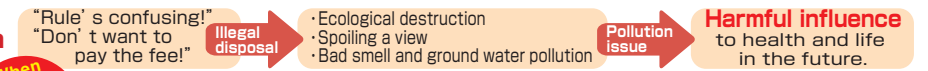
